

Devenir, meaning "to become" or "becoming" across multiple languages, is the *process* through which someone or something comes into being. It unfolds moment to moment, here and now.

Carolina Fontoura Alzaga creates your **Devenir** lighting sculpture, or lamp, at Facaro art studio, according to your personal preferences — from the color of the glass and the components to the material of the base and the engraved message of your choosing. The engraving can be a symbol, word, or phrase that nourishes you, expresses love for another, or honors the memory of someone significant — you determine its meaning.



CAROLINA (CARO) FONTOURA ALZAGA

I'm a Mexican-Brazilian artist. My work blends art, design, somatics, and justice, shaped by years of activism. I began creating lighting sculptures as introspective self-portraits, reflecting both my personal relationship to power and how larger power structures shape the world around us. Through my art, I explore the ways these forces intertwine, impacting our lives and society as a whole.

My internationally acclaimed **Connect** series and award-winning **Lucienne** series of lighting sculptures have garnered recognition and praise for their transformative impact, including coverage and mentions in the Los Angeles Times, American Craft, Luxe, New York Times, and Architectural Digest.

Connect has been commissioned for commercial and residential spaces in thirteen countries around the world. The Aurea edition within the Lucienne series was honored with the IIDA (International Interior Design Association) product award, cementing its status as a beacon of artistic excellence and innovation.

I recieved my BFA in 2007, after which I founded Facaro, my multidisciplinary art studio in Los Angeles, where I currently live and work.

Lucienne is in honor of my mother, Lupe Alzaga.
